The work will continue what was evolving as Tourism2030 which the Government had put on hold due to the COVID-19 pandemic.


Tourism operators are encouraged to fill out the easy-to-complete industry survey - see link below. Feedback is welcomed up to and by 11 June.


SME Recovery Loan Scheme


